## **Build Your Own Harbour Wall** Use simple materials to build your own protective harbour wall, just like the Mulberry Harbours that helped Allied troops land safely in Normandy. Discover how prefabrication and teamwork played a huge part in one of the biggest engineering challenges of the war. Will your harbour keep the waves at bay?

## You'll Need:

- Small boxes, bricks, or LEGO
- A tray or large shallow box (to act as the sea)
- Water (optional for realism!)
- Blue card or tissue paper

Engineers used over 31,000 tonnes of steel to build 212 real caissons!

## Steps:

- 1. Use the tray or box as your "sea".
- Place your boxes or bricks to form a harbour wall — try making a curved wall to protect an inner area.
- 3. Use blue paper to create waves and add paper boats to the protected "harbour".
- 4. Try removing parts of your wall what happens to the harbour inside?
